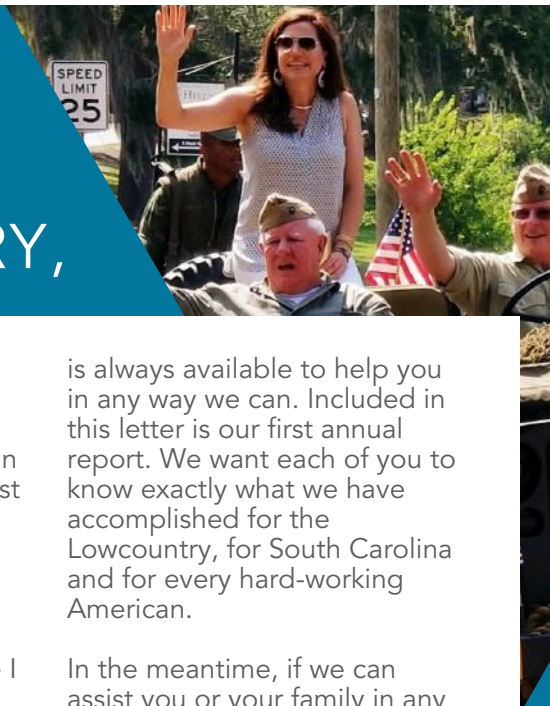

NUMBERS

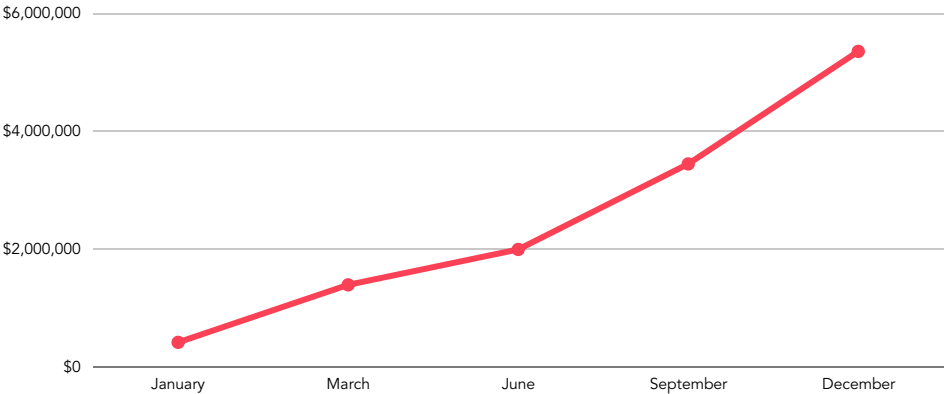

ACTIVE DUTY AND MILITARY VETS

- INTRODUCED the Save Parris Island Act to prevent the closure of the Marine Corps Recruiting Depot in Beaufort.
- INTRODUCED the Tiny Homes For Veterans Act to create affordable housing for homeless and at-risk veterans.
- INTRODUCED Ending Veterans Homelessness Act to expand assistance to homeless veterans.
- INTRODUCED the Military Sexual Trauma Retirement Pay Equity Act to support military retirees suffering from military sexual trauma.
- INTRODUCED the Veterans Cyber Risk Awareness Act to educate veterans of the cyber threats online they may encounter.
- INTRODUCED and passed 3 amendments to the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA).

COASTAL CONSERVATION

- FIRST ENVIRONMENTAL AND WILDLIFE WIN was Crab Bank in the first 12 weeks in office!
- INTRODUCED legislation to BAN offshore drilling off SC's coast.
- JOINED the Conservative Climate Caucus.
- SPONSORED the Trillion Trees Act.
- ONE of only 8 Republicans to support the American Shores Protection Act to ban offshore drilling off the coast of SC.
- AUTHORED joint letter to the USFWS advocating for an exemption for the Folly Beach project's use of the Folly River CBRA zone.
- INTRODUCED - The National Disaster Safety Board Act with Rep. Katie Porter (D-CA) to improve natural disaster response times and strengthen recovery plans.

UNCOVERING WASTE, FRAUD, & ABUSE

- UNCOVERED billions in possible fraudulent small business grants at the Pentagon.
- INTRODUCED the FREE Act to protect the rights of those in conservatorships.
- INTRODUCED the ENCRYPT Act to ensure an encryption policy for protecting citizens' data.
- SPONSORED 2 bills to ban taxpayer funding of CRT - Stop CRT Act and Combatting Racist Training in the Military Act.



CIVIL RIGHTS AND CIVIL LIBERTIES

- INTRODUCED the States Reform Act to end the criminalization of cannabis while protecting states' rights to allow or prohibit cannabis as they see fit; allows businesses to operate legally and pay taxes; protects veterans, expunges nonviolent cannabis offenses, protects kids, and more.
- ONLY freshman serving as the highest Ranking Member of a subcommittee on Oversight and Reform (Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Subcommittee); in other words Rep. Mace is leading the Republican or minority side of the committee.
- INTRODUCED legislation with Sen. Kramer (R-ND) to enforce voter ID laws in states that require vaccine passports.
- SPONSORED the Disaster Assistance Equity Act with Rep. Nadler to ensure communities across the Lowcountry have equal access to FEMA resources after disasters.

Big Bipartisan Wins

- EXPOSED NIH's and NIAID's cruel experiments on beagle puppies - underscoring Dr. Fauci's policies re animal testing are barbaric.
- EXPOSED gruesome Rhesus monkey testing off the coast of SC-01 on Morgan Island - also under NIH and NIAID.
- HOUSE PASSED Rep. Mace's bill in legislation for her initiative to Extend Tuition Assistance to Gold Star families and veterans.
- HOUSE PASSED Rep. Mace's bill, Federal Rotational Cyber Workforce Act, with Rep. Khanna, to develop a highly-skilled cyber workforce.
- HOUSE PASSED Rep. Mace's civil rights legislation to protect attorney-client privileges between defendants and lawyers.
- HOUSE PASSED Rep. Mace's 3 amendments to NDAA.



GRANTS FOR THE LOWCOUNTRY

- HELPED SECURE \$1.3m awarded to the South Coast Cyber Center in Beaufort via the US Department of Defense Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation grant.
- SUPPORTED Dorchester County receiving FY 2021 RAISE Grant money to complete Phase 3 of the U.S. Highway 78 Project.
- HELPED SECURE \$25 million for the Palmetto Railways under the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant program to support the Port of Charleston in clearing a cargo bottleneck.
- SUPPORTED local small businesses receiving the Shuttered Venue Operators Grant and signed onto a letter urging the Small Business Administration to expedite these grants.

DISTRICT ENGAGEMENTS

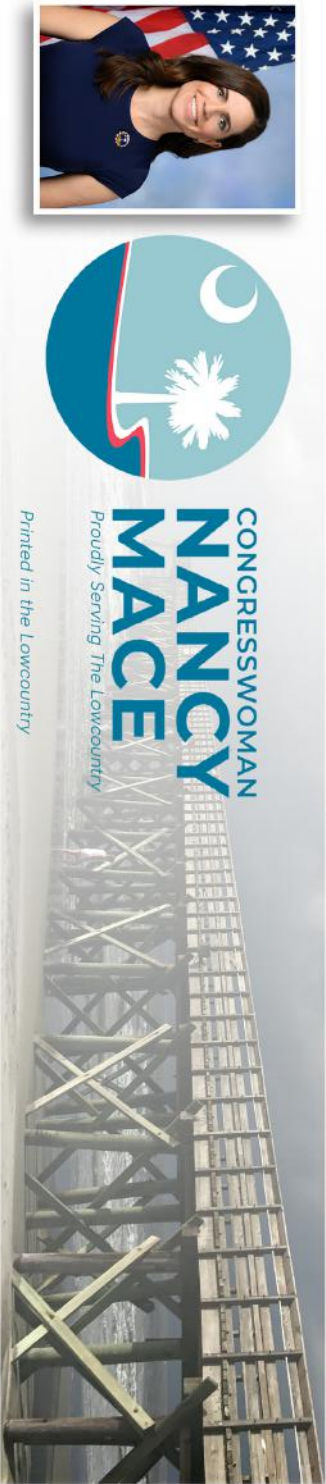
- HOSTED 15 TOWN HALLS either in person or by telephone throughout the district.
- ENSURED our nation's service academies continue to receive the best and brightest from the Lowcountry - we pushed for a record number of applicants this year, and received over 50!
- ENGAGED all local elected officials to include, mayors, state legislators, and county officials in quarterly meetings ensuring your voice is heard in Washington.
- ENGAGED Operation Patriots FOB to highlight in my official capacity a new Lowcountry nonprofit striving to prevent veteran suicide.
- ADDRESSED immigration visa concerns from business leaders in the Hilton Head/Bluffton area about the low caps on H2B and J1 visas for the record tourism season.
- SUPPORTED the Lowcountry's hospitals, healthcare providers, and partners to ensure our medical community was fully stocked with PPE, COVID-19 tests and vaccinations throughout the pandemic.
- CONTINUED Civil Rights, Prison and Law Enforcement Reforms - Following the horrific death of Jamal Sutherland, Congresswoman Mace engaged key voices in the mental health and criminal justice communities throughout the Lowcountry to begin to develop much-needed, overdue criminal justice and civil rights reforms. Her passion for these issues is one of primary reasons Rep. Mace is now the highest ranking Republican on the Civil Rights subcommittee.
